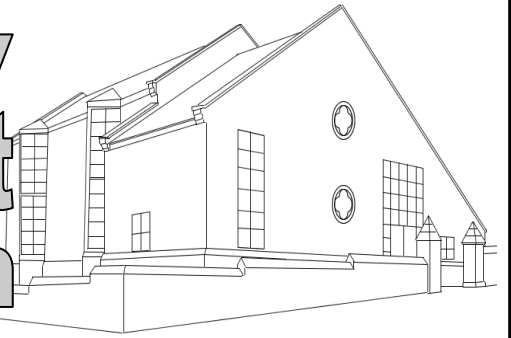

Church Council Finance Update

At the last Church Council, the meeting made the following donations from church funds: £600 to the Down Syndrome Training & Support Service, based at The Pamela Sunter Centre on Whitley Street, £150 to Rewind and £50 to the Methodist Fund for Property.

It was also agreed to increase the amount we contribute to The Airedale Circuit by £1,200 to £37,600 per year, which is an increase of around 3.3% on what we're currently paying.
