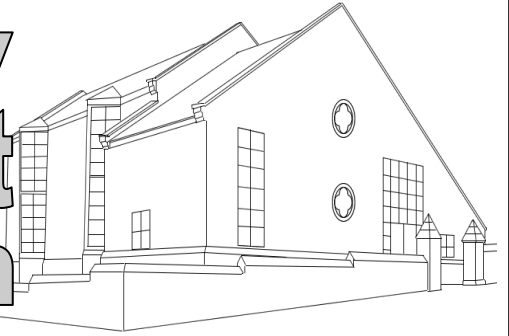

Jerr Wood is a piece of land at the top of Binns Street, off Belgrave Road, on the side opposite to Herbert Street. The Jerr Wood Action Group has organised a community event on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> June from 2 to 4 as part of the Jo Cox Foundation's Great Get Together. This will take the form of a community picnic with activities at Jerr Wood, with the aim of bringing together local people of all ages and backgrounds, including any who may be lonely. Food is being provided by the Jerr Wood Action Group, who have received a small grant from Bingley Town Council and members of our Church community are contributing by baking cakes for the occasion. Members of the Church community will be welcome to take part in this event which is guided by Jo's conviction that we all have more in common than that which divides us and that compassion and optimism are signs of strength and not weakness.
